Wherever possible, CMS' RDS Center has streamlined processes by redesigning Secure Website pages, combining related steps, removing redundant steps, and renaming steps to make them more intuitive.

Assign Payment/Cost Privilege to Designee(s)	<a href="#">Identify Payment Requesters</a>  and  <a href="#">Identify Cost Reporters</a>	Account Manager Authorized Representative
Specify Vendors for Cost Reporting	<a href="#">Identify Cost Reporters</a>	Account Manager Authorized Representative
